## **MAIN DUTIES**

- 1. Assist the Senior Maintenance Technician in implementing the planned, preventative maintenance programme;
- 2. Perform compliance testing and maintain accurate records;
- 3. Support general maintenance tasks and seasonal operations;
- 4. Prepare rooms for events and examinations;
- 5. Conduct site inspections and complete minor remedial repairs where needed;
- 6. Carry out minor electrical, mechanical, plumbing, decorative, and structural repairs where needed;
- 7. Handle manual transportation of equipment and materials;
- 8. Provide cover for maintenance and reprographics functions when required;
- 9. Respond promptly to building management queries and emergencies, following College procedures;
- 10. Maintain statutory compliance documentation, including PPM schedules and contractor reports;
- 11. Manage and liaise with contractors as directed;
- 12. Work outside normal hours when necessary;
- 13. Undertake driving duties as required;
- 14. Update Estates systems to ensure accurate data;
- 15. Support monitoring of contractor performance and remedial actions;
- 16. Assist with tracking site inspections and testing regimes;
- 17. Conduct routine health and safety checks and support policy implementation;
- 18. Report defects and unsafe conditions promptly and ensure corrective actions are taken;
- 19. Assist with evacuation drills and lockdown procedures;



- 20. Maintain high standards of cleanliness and organisation across the site;
- 21. Raise purchase orders and support procurement processes;
- 22. Complete Estates administration tasks, including emails and summary reports;
- 23. Contribute to sustainability initiatives;
- 24. Support minor works and capital projects as directed.

## 25. Other duties

- 1. Use those I.T. packages and systems available for the rapid and efficient completion of job tasks;
- 2. Safeguard and promote the welfare of children, young people and vulnerable adults;
- 3. Ensure that safe working practices are adopted in compliance with relevant health and safety regulations.
- 4. Demonstrate commitment to the principles of equality of opportunity and treatment, and comply with the requirements of relevant equal opportunities legislation.
- 5. Attend and contribute to appropriate team meetings in order to enhance co-operative working relationships and standards of service delivery.
- 6. Participate in performance management procedures.
